# NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Two (2) vacancies on Hawaii Central Federal Credit Union's Board of Directors will be filled at our 2023 Annual Meeting to be hosted on Saturday, April 1, 2023.

#### **NOMINATIONS**

Two (2) nominations were filed and submitted to fill the two (2) Board vacancies with the Board of Directors Secretary by the Nominating Committee on December 30, 2022. They are: Neil Shimogawa and Garret Kawamura. Their profiles are listed at hawaiicentral.org/boardnominees

Additional nominations from the membership may be made by petition only; nominations will not be accepted from the floor on the day of the Annual Meeting. If you are interested in serving on the Board and would like to submit a petition for nomination, please call Pamela Regidor, Executive Assistant at (808) 441-7341 for a list of qualifications and a petition packet.

The nominating petition, a statement of qualifications and certification of intent to serve if elected to office, must be received by the Board Secretary on or before February 20, 2023. Nominees accepted by petition will be added to the ballot for voting at the Annual Meeting.

If no nominees are accepted by petition, there will be two (2) vacancies and two (2) nominees, so there will not be a vote.



Garret Kawamura (Incumbent)

Business Director, Department of Surgery, University Health Partners of Hawaii

Garret is a member of Hawaii Central FCU since February 2016 and was a member of The Queen's Federal Credit Union since 2003. He has served on The Queen's FCU Board of Directors and was the Chairman of the Supervisory Committee from 2004 to 2016. He has been an active Hawaii Central FCU volunteer since 2016 serving on the Board of Directors.

Garret is seeking re-election to the Board of Directors to continue meeting the needs of our members and the community. He hopes to utilize the experience he gained serving on the Board of Directors for The Queen's FCU and Kuakini Medical FCU.
